

Make this family of chicks for an eggs-tremely fluffy Easter... Start



First, you need to make a template for your chick. Use the compass to draw two circles on the cardboard – 10cm across with a 3cm smaller circle in the centre. Cut out the circles and then the smaller centre circles



For the chick's feet, cut out two 'D' shapes from the felt or orange card, and stick

them onto the base of the chick

using the craft glue. Cut one small triangle from the orange

felt or card for the chick's beak,

and coat the base of the beak
