Page 18 — Written Addition

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{Q1} \quad 342 \\ + 427 \\ \hline 769 \end{array} \quad (1 \text{ mark})$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 6367 \\ + 954 \\ \hline 7321 \end{array} \quad (1 \text{ mark})$$

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{Q2} \quad 2745 \\ + 1534 \\ \hline 4279 \end{array} \quad (1 \text{ mark})$$

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{Q3} \quad 2758 \\ + 6273 \\ \hline 9031 \end{array}$$

(2 marks for all correct, otherwise 1 mark for 3 correct.)

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{Q4} \quad 8.10 \\ + 1.95 \\ \hline 10.05 \end{array}$$

So she pays **£10.05** in total. (1 mark)

Page 19 — Written Subtraction

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{Q1} \quad 961 \\ - 256 \\ \hline 705 \end{array} \quad (1 \text{ mark})$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 2395 \\ - 1689 \\ \hline 706 \end{array} \quad (1 \text{ mark})$$

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{Q2} \quad 579 \\ - 384 \\ \hline 195 \end{array} \quad (1 \text{ mark})$$

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{Q3} \quad 1764 \\ - 167 \\ \hline 1597 \end{array} \quad (1 \text{ mark})$$

So the difference in price is **£6.15**. (1 mark)
