

Make your own Easter Nests

Adult supervision required





Ingredients ...

1 box of Shredded Wheat (16 large or 500g bite size biscuits)

400g milk chocolate 2 x 100g bags of Mini Eggs Bun cases

Instructions ...

- Crush the Shredded Wheat biscuits into a bowl with a spoon or your hands.
- Melt your chocolate in a bowl then mix it into your crushed Shredded Wheat.
- Now mix these two ingredients together making sure all the Shredded Wheat is covered with chocolate.
- Spoon the mixture into your bun cases and press down in the middle of your nest so you can place your eggs on top (place 3-4 eggs in each nest).
- Leave the nests to set for at least 2 hours in your fridge.



Make an Easter Chick Card

Adult supervision required



You will need ...

- Scissors
- Pencil
- 2 paper fasteners
- · 2 sheets of yellow paper
- 1 sheet of orange paper
- 2 large wiggle eyes
- Black permanent marker or crayon



Instructions ...

- 1 Trace your handprints onto your yellow paper and cut these out.
- 2 Draw an oval shape onto the yellow paper and also cut this out.
- Lay the oval on the table and attach your wings (handprints) to the back of the oval shape with your paper fasteners (so your wings can move).
- Cut out your beak shape and glue this to the front side of your oval shape and then glue on your wiggle eyes.
- **5** Glue on your chick's legs to the back of the oval.
- Then to finish off write your special Easter message on your card in permanent marker or crayon.



Handprint Easter Chicks

Adult supervision required

You will need ...

- Paper
- Yellow and orange paint
- Black pen






Instructions ...

- For each chick print a yellow handprint with your fingers together.
- To create yellow beaks dip one fingertip in orange paint and print onto your handprint.
- 3 Leave to dry.
- With the black pen draw on the chicks' wings, eyes and feet.

What you need:

- White and pink craft foam

- Pink pen
- Pink gem or sticker
- 🦀 Glue
- Cardboard egg box
- Template

Easter Bunny Instructions:

- Cut out one section of an egg box.
- Use the template given to cut out your bunny from white foam.
- Glue on the eyes, pink foam ears and pink gem nose.
- 4. With a pen draw on some whiskers.
- 5. Bend both edges to form a loop and glue them together.
- Place the cut out section of the egg box inside the loop to hold the boiled egg.


What you need:
