

What Is a Fabergé Egg?

A Fabergé egg is a jeweled decorative egg.

They were made by Peter Carl Fabergé, between 1885 and 1917.





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
The Fabergé eggs were made for the Russian Royal family, with the first one being made for Tsar Alexander III to give to his wife as a gift.

They are very rare as only 65 were ever made.
