#### Egg or no Egg?

We are going to learn which creatures hatch from eggs. Follow the instructions given.

- 1. First, on A4 paper draw an egg shape.
- 2. Next, look at the following page and guess which animals hatch from eggs. If you think the animal hatches from an egg, then write it down inside of the egg otherwise write it outside.
- 3. Then, see the PowerPoint attached.
- 4. After that, come back to the egg and see if anything needs changing.
- Finally, you can make a new Easter Egg. Draw and colour the animals that hatch from eggs inside. This will be your final piece of work so remember it needs to look presentable.



### **Create Easter egg holders**



#### To make the bunny, you will need:

- White and pink craft foam.
- Googly eyes
- Pink pen
- Pink gem or sticker
- Glue
- Cardboard egg box

Note: If you can't find some materials at home you can use another items such as colour paper, card, paper towel rolls, paper plates, buttons, play dough.

#### Instructions:

- 1. Cut out one section from the egg box.
- An adult can create a template to use to cut out your bunny from white foam and the inner ears from pink foam.

- 3. Glue on the eyes, pink foam ears and pink gem nose, and with a pen draw on some whiskers.
- 4. Bend the edges to form a loop and glue together, or staple for extra hold.
- 5. Pop the cardboard egg box section into the loop to hold your egg.

#### To make the chick, you will need:

- Yellow and orange craft foam
- Googly eyes
- Glue
- Cardboard egg box

#### Instructions:

- 1. Cut out one section from the egg box.
- An adult to create a template so you can cut out your chick and its wings from yellow foam. Also use the template to cut out the chick's beak from orange foam.

- 3. Glue on the eyes, orange foam beak and yellow foam wings. Bend the edges to form a loop and glue together, or staple for extra hold.
- Pop the cardboard egg box section into the loop to hold your egg.
