

# *Year 4 Easter ideas*



Have fun playing this classic game with your family – pin the tail on the rabbit. Make your own bunny using card, paint and cotton wool!

## **Instructions**

- Place blu tack or pin on the end of the rabbit tail that joins the rabbit body.
- Hang the rabbit picture on a wall that is roughly eye level to you.
- Whoever is playing lines up in single file and first child in the queue is blind folded.
- Give them the rabbit tail and gently spin them around three times.
- Point the blindfolded child towards the rabbit and ask them to place the tail on the rabbit.
- Mark the spot where they place the tail with their name. Once every child has had a turn, the child with the tail closest to the correct position wins. Have fun!

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## **Rainbow eggs**
