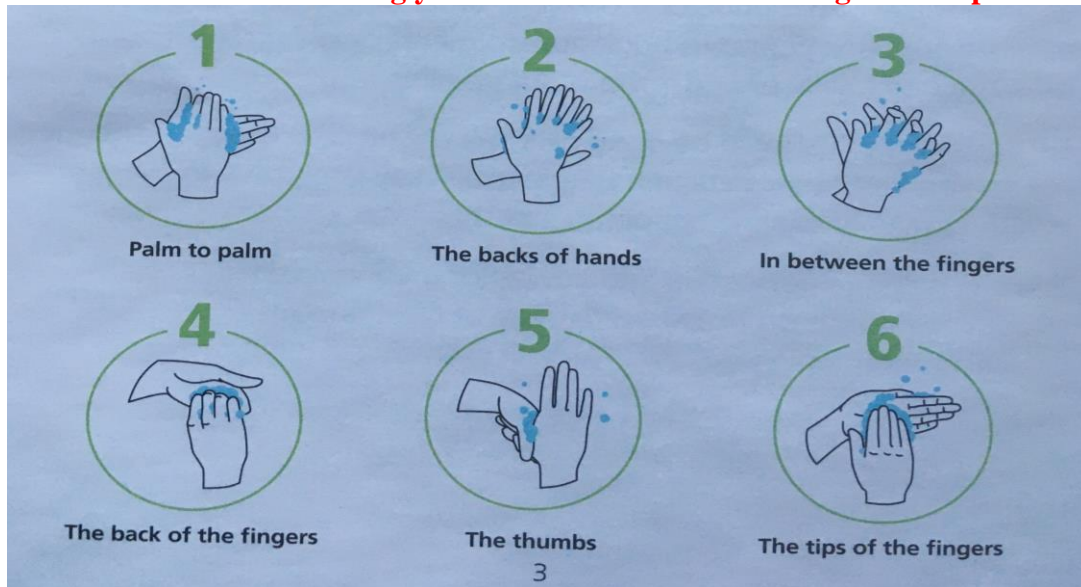


Dear children,

**Reminder about washing your hands for 20 seconds using the 6 steps.**



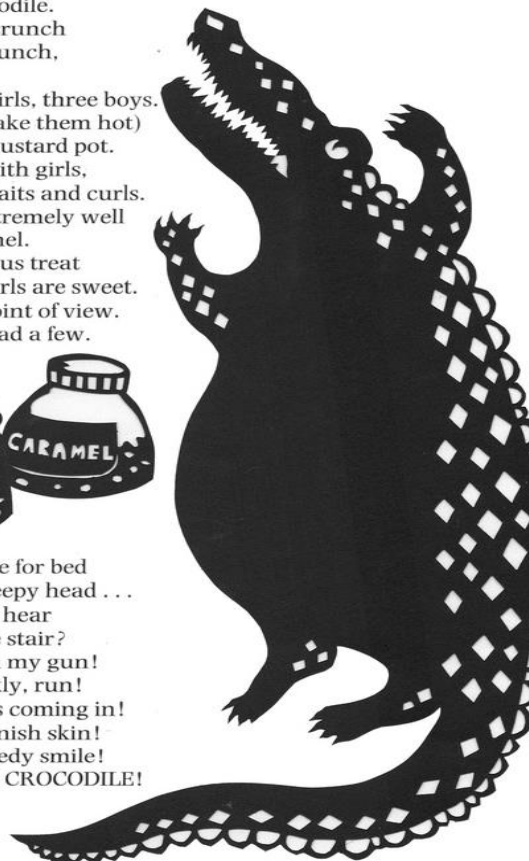
Today we would like to send you something that will make you smile – a funny poem by Roald Dahl.

-Select 5-6 lines from the poem and practise your handwriting. Don't forget correct letter formation and join all the letters.

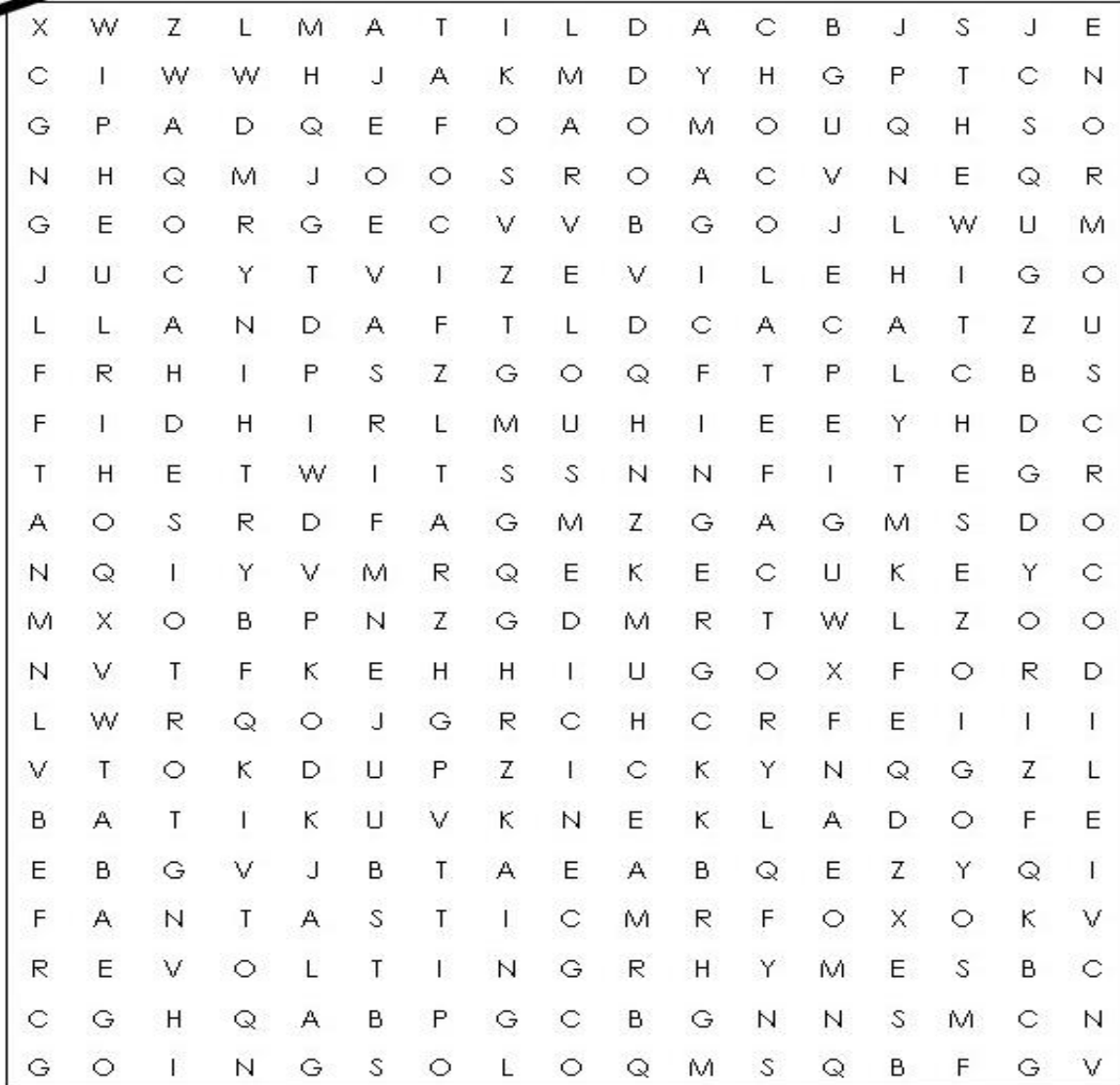
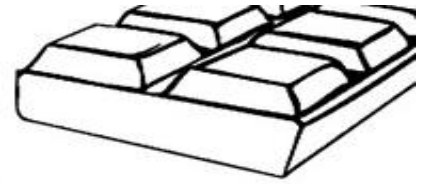
### **Staying fit and healthy**

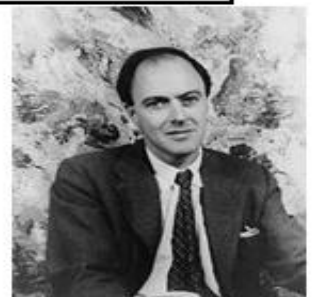
