



Recycled Creative Crayons

Recycle all your little pieces of crayons into brand new usable ones!

You will need:

- Small pieces of old crayons (without their wrappers)
- Silicone baking moulds
- Baking sheet

Method

1. Preheat your oven to 200°C/gas mark 6.
2. Make sure that you have removed all the wrappers from your little bits of crayons.
3. Fill your moulds with your crayon bits. You could choose to mix the colours up to make new multicoloured crayons or you could stick to the same colour. It's up to you!
4. Slightly overfill each mould because as they melt, the crayons will take up less room in the mould.
5. Place your mould on a baking sheet and put it in the oven for 10-15 minutes or until your crayons are completely melted.
6. Allow your crayons to cool completely.
7. Remove them from the moulds and enjoy colouring with your new recycled crayons!


