SHORT AND LONG SOUND

Hello!

Today we are learning about the sound.

You already know that different instruments make different sound.

You also can make a sound – using your own voice.

Today we are talking about **SHORT** and **LONG** sound.

We call it **DURATION** of the **SOUND**

The easiest way to see how sound can be long or short it's to use your **voice**. Take a deep breath and sing "Taaaaaaaaaaaaaaaaaaaaa" as long as you can So, you made a **LONG sound**

Now say very short "Ta Ta Ta Ta "
You made a **SHORT** sound

If you have a recorder in your house you can blow for a very long time and You will make again a **long sound**.
Or you can blow shortly and make a **short sound**.

Think about object in your house that you can use to make short or long sound (it should be safe)
