NOTE VALUES

QUAVER – SEMIQUAVER

QUAVER

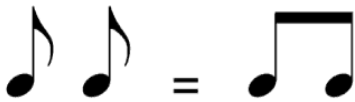
Note called **QUAVER** or “eighth note” is a $\frac{1}{2}$ of **CROTCHET** and $\frac{1}{8}$ of **SEMIBRIEVE**.

It's like a **crotchet** but, it also has a **tail** coming out of the side of its stem.

The tail halves the value of the note again and so a quaver has a value of half a beat.



You can also group quavers under one line, it's easier to write.



SEMIQUAVER

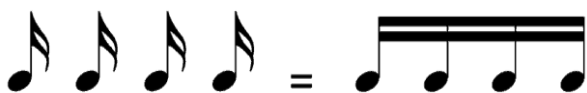
Up next, we have a **semiquaver** or “sixteenth note”.

It's a $\frac{1}{4}$ of the **crotchet** and $\frac{1}{2}$ of the **quaver**

It's like a quaver but has two tails coming out of its stem.



You can also group semiquavers under one line, it's easier to write
