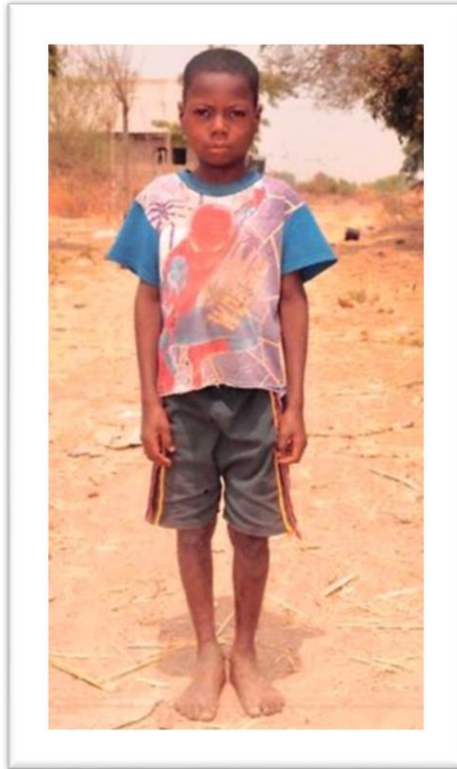




Action Aid – Year 5



Year 5 will be sponsoring Shamwillu who lives in Federal Capital Territory, in central Nigeria. He was born in 2012, he is one of a family of 4 children and speaks Gbagyi which is the national language.

Shamwillu's family are farmers, they grow crops or livestock to eat or sell. Most families only have a small plot of land which means money and food can be limited. He attends the local school but the quality of education is very poor as schools lack facilities and trained teachers. Education is not prioritised and instead children will help on farms to support the family.

Healthcare facilities are over 5km away and staff are poorly trained and equipment and medical supplies are limited and expensive. Drinking water is often polluted and can cause a number of health problems.

Our support will help to secure better education, access to healthcare and securing food supplies to Shamwillu and his family.

Throughout the year, we will be running fundraising events as part of our sponsorship program with Action Aid. We will also be writing to Shamwillu and he will also write back to the children.
