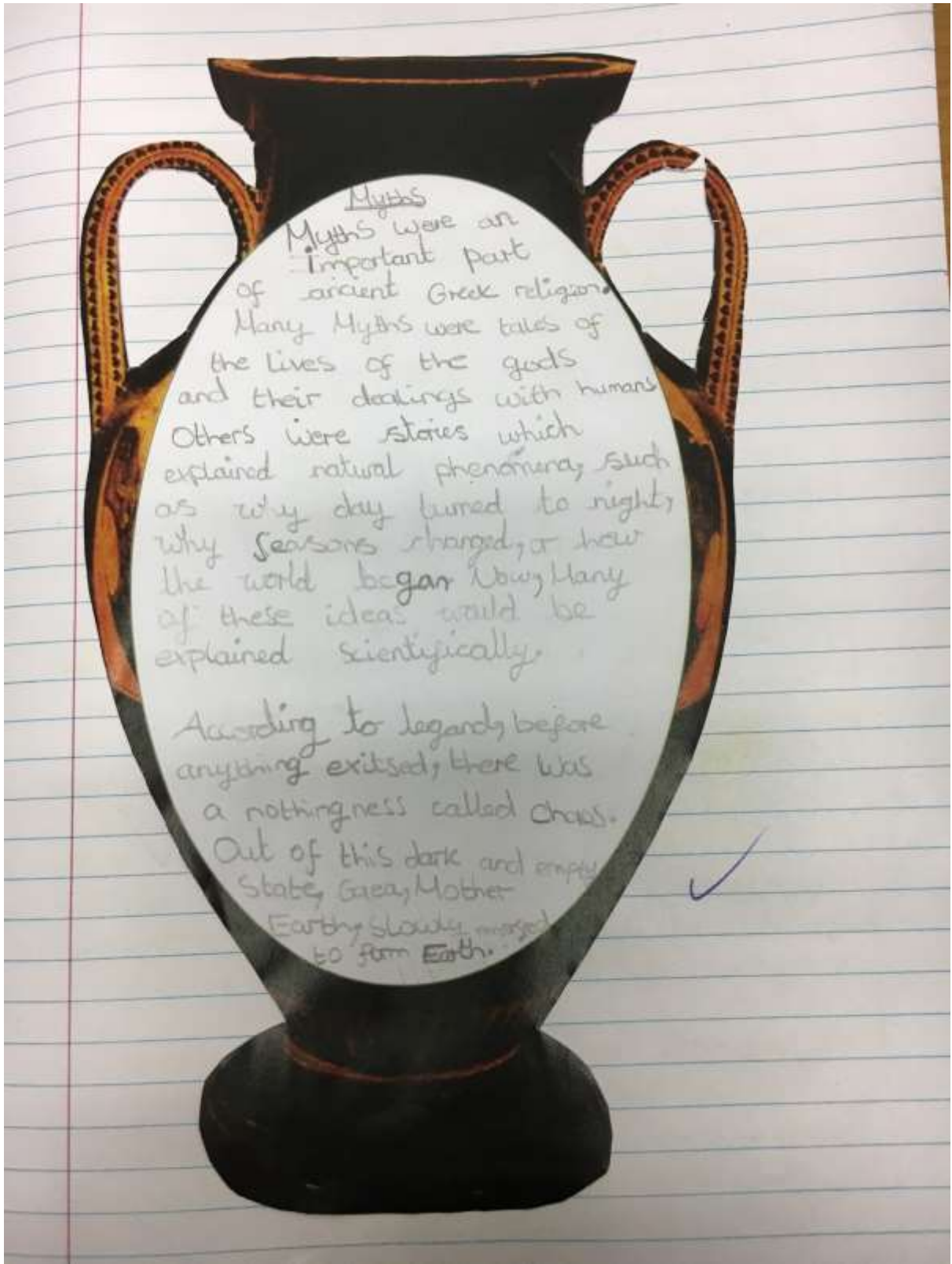
The girl in search

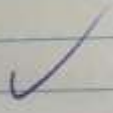
Without further ado, she quickly dashed across the enormous forest and soon amongst the tall twisted trees.
